

What is the JDS

The Project for Human Resource Development Scholarship by Japanese Grant Aid (JDS) was established by the Government of Sri Lanka with the assistance of the Government of Japan in 2010. The objective of JDS is to support human resources development of Sri Lanka, **targeting young government officials**, who are expected to be leaders of the country, and to engage in formulating and implementing social and economic development policies after their return. JDS Fellows shall contribute to an expanded and enhanced foundation for bilateral relations with Japan as persons having well-rounded knowledge of Japan.

Fields of Study

The framework of the JDS project consists of “**Sub-Program**” and “**Component**”, which correspond to and deal with the selected target priority area and development issues of Sri Lanka. JDS Fellows are selected from “**Target Organizations**” whose mission is closely related to “sub-program” and “component”. Accepting Japanese universities offer educational programs correspond to the needs. The degree to be obtained is **master’s degree**. The medium of instruction is **English**.

Allowances for JDS Applicants

All the selection costs will be covered by JDS Project, including Fee for IELTS Test and health check-up

Scholarship Benefits for JDS Fellows

JDS is a FULL scholarship program, including:

- (1) One round trip airfare
- (2) Monthly living allowance
- (3) Full tuition fees at Japanese accepting universities
- (4) Other designated allowances (buying book, Shipping, Travel and Seminar attendance, overseas travel insurance)

Qualifications for Applicants

- (1) Citizen of Sri Lanka
- (2) Below the age of 40 as of 1st April in the year of dispatch (in principle)
- (3) - Completed the undergraduate level (bachelor degree) of education
- Has a good command of both written and spoken English at graduate level
- (4) Completed the probation period and eligible for confirmation
- (5) "Executives/ Senior Executives", those who are mentioned in the Public Administration Circular No.06/2006, Annexure II, Page 2, IV Senior Level, and Page 5, 3.10 & 3.11
- Officials those who belong to Board of Investment (BOI) can only apply to CP 1-3 "Business Management"
- Officials those who belong to National Building Research Organization (NBRO), Central Environmental Authority (CEA), National Water Supply and Drainage Board (NWSDB), Waste Management Authority (WMA) can only apply to CP 1-4 "Environment Management/ Disaster Management and Climate Change"
* Study topics that are highly relevant to applicants' career development & beneficial to their organization will be given highest priority
- (6) A person of sound mind and body
Note: Applicants need to take and pass all medical check-up at the time of Comprehensive Interview. This medical check-up is arranged by JDS Project Office. Applicant who cannot take or pass all medical check-up will be disqualified from JDS scholarship.
- (7) A person falls under any of the following items is not eligible to apply:
 - Military personnel registered on the active list or person on alternative military service
 - Those who are currently awarded or scheduled to receive another scholarship
 - Those who have obtained a master's or higher degree overseas under the support of foreign scholarship
