Foreign Training Opportunities

Technical Assistance Programme for 2013 / 2014

The Department of External Resources (ERD) is in the process of finalizing the technical assistance programme for 2013/2014. Therefore, the training programmes that were offered regularly by development partners in the previous years are included in the schedule as a guide to identify the training programmes. Announcements of any other new and ad-hoc offers will be transmitted by the ERD when they are available. You are kindly requested to fill up your training requirements (only the name of the programme) indicating <u>separately</u> in respect of each development partner and be sent by using the format ("Foreign Training Requirements") given in Annex I. Requests of all the institutions under your Ministry should be consolidated in one format and arranged according to the order of priority for each partner.

After a strict scrutiny of all requests, only those programmes, which are directly relevant to functions and work programmes of the Ministry, should be included in the list with a brief justification for each request indicating its importance and relevance to the functions of the institution. The responses to this Circular will be treated as a demand survey to be used as a basis for negotiations on fellowships with development partners. The ERD will invite nominations at a later date on the basis of actual offers made by the development partners.

When sending your requirements for training programmes, the guidelines stipulated in this circular should be strictly adhered to. Seminars and Workshops less than one week duration are not included in this circular. Such programmes are generally meant for senior officials of the public service and will be announced when they are available.

1.0 GENERAL GUIDELINES TO APPLY FOR THE TRAINING PROGRAMMES WHEN NOMINATIONS ARE INVITED BY ERD

- 1.1 The prospective candidates should have proficiency in English language according to the requirements of respective development partners. Generally for long term training a minimum score of 500 in TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or 6.0 in IELTS (International English Language Testing System) is required.
- 1.2 The prospective candidates should preferably be below 45 years of age. Further details are given in guidelines under each programme category.
- 1.3 Only one request should be made for any prospective candidate until the selection made by the development partners. In case if a candidate is nominated for more than one fellowship only the first nomination will be considered.
- 1.4 Candidates who have received one long term training course abroad under the Government sponsorship are not eligible for other long term training.
- 1.5 Candidates should have minimum of three years of Government service to be eligible for a long-term training.
- 1.6 Candidates should be managerial level public officials. Management Assistants, Data Entry Operators, Consultants, Advisors, Administrative Officers and Officers who are on contract basis are not considered under Technical Assistance Programme.
- 1.7 Less priority should be given to the candidates who have had short term or long term foreign training opportunities during the last 3 years.
- 1.8 The Government clearance to leave the country to participate in a foreign training programme has to be submitted to the relevant authority as per Appendix-16 to the PA circular No 21/2007 dated 11th September 2007 only after the offer is granted to nominees. (Please see Annex II for Appendix –

16). Please note that a copy of Appendix 16 should be submitted to ERD in order to keep records updated.

1.9 Those who have completed foreign training programmes are required to submit a report to ERD through the Head of Department within a month of arrival.

1.12 Submission of Nominations

· ·

- (a) Submission of Nominations should be made to ERD only when nominations are invited by ERD. When submissions are made, the internal procedures of the respective Ministry should be followed and necessary clearance should be obtained.
- (b) The ERD Form 2 "Essential Information of the Nominee" as given in Annex III must be completed and sent along with the application form for further processing by the ERD. NIC number should be written clearly in the form. Please note that we will be compelled to reject the nomination if the application and the ERD Form 2 are not properly completed and/or not submitted before the ERD closing date.
- (c) Chief Secretaries of Provincial Councils are requested to submit nominations through the Secretary of the Ministry of Local Government & Provincial Councils. They should obtain the concurrence of the Governor before submission of the application.
- (d) This circular, most of the Fellowship Applications, ERD Form 2 and Appendix 16 can be downloaded from <u>http://www.erd.gov.lk</u>.

All foreign training requirements of your Ministry (Only the title of the programme) and the institutions functioning under your purview should be submitted to ERD on or before 30th April 2013, using the format attached in Annex I. Any requests received after this date will not be considered for inclusion in the year 2013 / 2014 Technical Assistance Programme.

2.0 GUIDELINES FOR SHORT TERM TRAINING

The details of regular short-term training programmes (training programmes that have been awarded for the last two years) are given under each development partner's name. These training awards may be repeated for the next year. Details of the fields of training and duration are given in attached schedules.

2.1 Colombo Plan

21

The Technical Cooperation Scheme of Colombo Plan provides training assistance to the member countries to enhance the administrative and technical capabilities through human resource development. The total numbers of awards are around 30 particularly in the fields of Public Administration & Environment, Public Sector Development, Drug Advisory programmes and Long Term Scholarships Programmes. The duration of short term programmes range from 1 to 4. Please see **Schedule 1**.

2.2 Commonwealth Fund for Technical Cooperation (CFTC)

The CFTC provides around 30 short-term training programmes (less than a month) annually conducted in Commonwealth Developing Countries and around 75 placements are available under this programme for one financial year. Details of the short term training programmes are given in **Schedule 2**.

It has to be noted that the travel cost has to be met by the nominating agency. Specific application forms (GID 1 Part I & II) are available for CFTC programmes.

2.3 Government of China

Government of China offers about 65 short term training programmes (less than two months) and at least two candidates per programme will be selected. The main areas of the training provided by the Government of China are management, governance, cooperative management, agriculture, diplomatic training, economic planning, law, power and energy, railway, media, narcotics control, Chinese language, human rights and environment etc. For more details, please see **Schedule 3**.

2.4 Government of Egypt

The Government of Egypt annually offers about 11 training programmes only in the fields of agriculture and culture and arts. They are listed in the **Schedule 4**.

2.5 Government of Germany / (INWENT)

The Government of Germany offers short-term scholarships only in the field of sports. Officials who are under 40 years are eligible to apply for these programmes. Details are given in **Schedule 5.**

2.6 Government of India - Colombo Plan (India - CP)

Under the Colombo Plan – India Programme, the Government of India provides about 40 placements per year mainly in the fields of Improving Service Sector Skills,

Productivity, Labour Management, Vocational Training, Human Resource Development, International Marketing, Poverty Alleviation, Fisheries, Marine and Coastal Area Management. Preference will be given to candidates below 45 years of age. Once an India CP Programme offered, the recipient is ineligible for any other India CP Programme . Please see **Schedule 6**.

2.7 Government of India -Indian Technical Economic Cooperation - (ITEC)

Under ITEC- India Programme, the **Government of India** invites nominations for about 120 courses annually in the fields of Agriculture, Audit/Accounts, Commerce, Information Technology, Education, Finance, Science and Technology, Rural Development, Statistics, Water Resources, Transport etc. Preference will be given to candidates below 45 years of age. Once an ITEC Programme offered, the recipient is ineligible for any other ITEC Programme. Please see Schedule 7.

2.8 Government of Indonesia

Government of Indonesia offers about 10 short term training courses (less than 2 months) mainly in the fields of Agriculture, Tourism, Textile and Disaster Risk Management and Education for Computer based Industrial Automation. For more details, please see **Schedule 8**.

2.9 Government of Japan - Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA)

The Government of Japan provides training facilities through the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) under the following categories.

- (a) JICA Country Focused Group Training Programme
- (b) JICA Other Japanese Training Programmes (Special Programmes)

Nominations will not be accepted from the candidates who have been awarded JICA fellowships within the last 5 years period.

(a) JICA – Country Focused Group Training Programme

ERD may request JICA to provide training in Japan for a group of Sri Lankan participants. The total number of such programmes received by Sri Lanka is around 2. The average number of participants in a group varies from 15 to 20. The average duration varies from 2 to 4 weeks. The requested fields of training should be a specialized area, which is not covered by training programmes in category (a).

(b) Other Japanese Training Programmes (Special Programmes)

There are a few other short term programmes available from Japan organized by few other agencies in addition to the JICA training programmes. Please see **Schedule 09**.

2.10 Government of Republic of Korea

The Government of Republic of Korea annually offers around 100 training opportunities by way of providing 50 programmes through Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA). The list of training courses and duration are given in Schedule 10.

2.11 Government of Malaysia

. •

Government of Malaysia offers around 80 short term training courses (less than 2 months) mainly in the fields of Management, Governance, Cooperative Management, IT, Agriculture, Fire Fighting, English Language, Diplomatic training, Economic Planning, Project Planning, Irrigation, Animal Science, Auditing and Environment., etc. For more details, please see Schedule 11.

2.12 The Netherlands

The applications for these programmes will be processed in two phases.

Phase 1: Applications for Admission

The applicants who wish to avail the Netherlands Government Fellowship should first obtain a placement from a relevant university / institution in the Netherlands. The application forms for the relevant courses should be downloaded from the web site of the relevant institution or by contacting the relevant university / institution directly. Details are available at the web site: <u>http://www.nuffic.nl/</u>

Duly completed application forms should be forwarded with the recommendation and the respective agency to the University or Institution **directly** before the academic deadline stipulated in the brochure for the respective course.

Phase 2: Applications for Fellowships

The applicants who have obtained the admission to respective courses in Netherlands will only be considered for the fellowship. They are requested to submit the fellowship application forms online with necessary documents with ERD endorsement before the fellowship application deadline given in the brochure. The applicant should be required to submit a copy of the fellowship application to obtain ERD endorsement. The fellowship application forms for the relevant courses can be downloaded from the web site: <u>http://www.nuffic.nl/nfp/.</u>

2.13 Pakistan

• . •

There are few training programmes offered by the Government of Pakistan in the fields of Banking, Accounting and Railway. Annually about 8 awards are made. Please see Schedule 12.

2.14 South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC)

Ten short term training programmes are available under SAARC assistance. Details of the programmes are given in **Schedule 13**.

2.15 Singapore

The Singapore training programme consists of about 70 courses. The duration of many of these training courses are less than one month. Most of the awards do not include the international travel costs. Please see **Schedule 14** for more details.

2.16 Government of Thailand - Thailand Technical Cooperation Programme (TICA)

The list of training **programmes** offered under the Thailand Technical Cooperation Programme (TICA) **Government** of Thailand is given in **Schedule 15**. The total number of awards is about 20 and the duration ranges between 1 week to 3 months. Main areas of the programmes are Health, Environment, Agriculture and Fisheries. Maximum numbers of placements are about 2 per programme, if the conditions are fulfilled.

3.0 GUIDELINES FOR LONG TERM TRAINING

3.1 Australian Awards Scholarships (AAS)

Around 25 fellowships are available under the Australian Awards Scholarships (AAS) (earlier Australian Development Scholarships Programme- ADS) for long term training in the Universities of Australia and scholarships will not be granted to public officials for Ph.d studies.

The priority areas for the year 2013_intake under the AAS programme are Sustainable Economic Growth, Education and Health sectors. Candidates must have a minimum IELTS (academic module) overall score of **6.5 with no band less than 6.0** at the time

they apply in order to qualify for postgraduate training. Many Australian Universities request IELTS overall score of **6.5** for ADS programmes. The selections will be done based on the Academic and Professional qualifications, experience of the service and written test. Please see **Schedule 16**.

3.2 Colombo Plan

Four long-term (Masters Level) programmes are available from Colombo Plan. Please see Schedule 17.

3.3 Government of Brunei

The Government of Brunei offers long term programmes for the government officials to follow post graduate degrees and students to follow undergraduate degrees in the universities of Brunei in the fields of Teaching, Education, Counseling, Energy Studies, Computing, News Media and economics and Policy Studies. The prospective candidates should have minimum score of 550 in TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or 6.0 in IELTS (International English Language Testing System) are required. ERD is not responsible for the undergraduate programmes.

The prospective candidates should preferably be below 35 years of age. Details are given in **Schedule 18**.

3.4 Government of China

Two long term (Master Level) programmes are available from Government of China in the fields of Education Policy and Human Resources Management. Please see **Schedule 19**.

3.5 Government of Germany - DAAD Training Programme

The Government of Germany offers scholarships through the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD). The DAAD Scholarships are available to young graduates from all academic disciplines. Basic knowledge of German will be an added qualification. Main fields of studies are Management, Regional Development, and Horticulture. The participants will be selected on international competitive basis. Please see Schedule **20**.

3.6 Government of Indonesia

There are 5 long term programmes available from the Government of Indonesia and they are listed in the **Schedule 21**.

3.7 Government of Italy

The Government of Italy offers scholarships to follow Masters Programme in law. Details are given in Schedule 22.

3.8 Government of Japan

The Government of Japan offers limited number of long term training programmes to Sri Lanka. Details of the Programmes are given in **Schedule 23**.

The Government of Japan offers 15 long term scholarships per year under the Japanese Grant Aid for Human Resources Development Scholarship (JDS) in addition to the schedule 38, 39, and 40 to pursue Post Graduate Studies in Japanese Universities. Identified target areas for the JDS programme are Public Policy & Public Finance, Public Administration, Regional Development & Poverty Alleviation, Macro Economic and Development Economics.

Nominees for this training programme should be below 40 years of age and should have at least 3 years of experience in a managerial level position in the public sector. Candidates must have a minimum IELTS (academic module) overall score of 5.5. Public Officials from all island services are entitled to apply for this programme.

3.9 People's Republic of Korea

Government of Korea offers 15 long term programmes and 30 awards in the fields of Public Administration, Public Sector Development, Information Technology, Trade and Commerce, International Relations, and Economic Development. Nominees for this training programme should be below 40 years of age and details of the programmes are listed in the Schedule 24.

3.10 Government of the Netherlands

The applications for these programmes will be processed in two phases.

Phase 1: Application for Admission

The applicants who wish to avail the Netherlands Government Fellowship should first obtain a placement from a university / institution in the Netherlands. There will be around 350 long term programmes available for each year.

The application forms for the relevant courses should be downloaded from the web site of the relevant institution or by contacting the relevant university / institution directly. Details are available at the web site: <u>http://www.nuffic.nl/</u>

Duly completed application forms should be forwarded with your recommendation to the relevant university or Institution **directly** at least one-month prior to the admission deadline given in the brochure for the course.

Phase 2: Application for Fellowship

The applicants who have obtained the admission to respective courses will only be considered for the fellowship. They are requested to submit the fellowship application form with necessary documents in four sets to ERD at least two-weeks prior to the fellowship application deadline given in the brochure to submit with Government approval to the Embassy of the Netherlands. One copy of the ERD form 2 should be submitted with the fellowship application. The fellowship application forms for the relevant programmes (Master's Degree Programme) can be downloaded from the web site: <u>http://www.nuffic.nl/nfp/.</u> Kindly be noted that applicants who have not submitted a copy of the application for admission to the ERD will not be recommended for the fellowship.

3.11 Government of Rumania

The Government of Rumania offers scholarships to follow Masters programmes in the fields of Political and Administrative Science, Education Studies, Rumanian Culture and Civilization, Journalism, Technical Studies, Oil and Gas, Agricultural Studies, Veterinary Medicine, Architecture and Art. Applicants should be followed these course in Rumanian Languages. Details are given in Schedule 25.

3.12 Government of Thailand

There are 25 long-term programmes available from the Government of Thailand and they are listed in the **Schedule 26**.
