PROCUREMENT OF THE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES
UNDER JAPAN'S GRANT AID 2004
IN RESPONSE TO THE DAMAGES CAUSED BY THE GREAT EARTHQUAKE
OFF THE COAST OF SUMATRA, THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,
AND BY THE INDIAN OCEAN TSUNAMI DISASTER

The Government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has received Grant Aid of eight billion Japanese Yen (¥8,000,000,000) from the Government of Japan for the purchase of products and services necessary for the execution of the Programme for Efforts to cope with the Damages caused by the Great Earthquake off the Coast of Sumatra, the Republic of Indonesia, and by the Indian Ocean Tsunami Disaster .

This is to announce the prequalification prior to the tender for the following project:

which comprises of the following major works:

-Two abutments with about 12.5m-long piles of 500mm-dia., 8 piles in total

-Steel truss girder of 30 meters in length

-Ductile cast-iron pipe of 60 meters in length

(All works are expected to be completed within six months from the commencement date.)

Prequalification Documents are available at the following office of the Employer, Japan International Cooperation System (JICS), from June 13 to June 16, 2005 from 10:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 16:00

The application forms shall be submitted to the said office by 17:00 on June 23, 2005.

The applicants, however, shall be required to satisfy the following conditions:

1. To be Sri Lankan construction companies of M1, M2, M3 or M4 ranking by Institute for Construction Training And Development (ICTAD), or Japanese general construction companies, which are equivalent to M1 ranking by ICTAD, registered in Japanese Commerce and Industry Association in Sri Lanka.
2. To be in sound financial conditions.
3. To have experiences of at least three (3) completed general construction works with contract price of not less than Three hundred thousand US dollars (US\$300,000) each, or have the cumulative completed general construction works of which the total contract price shall not be less than Three million US dollars (US\$3,000,000), either domestic or overseas, during the last ten (10) years, regardless of prime contracting or subcontracting.
4. To have experiences of at least three (3) completed construction works similar in nature to the works under this contract, either domestic or overseas, during the last ten (10) years, regardless of prime contracting or subcontracting.

5. To have not less than five (5) engineers who have been licensed in Sri Lanka or Japan.
