Nomination Request (01st Phase) – 2026

The Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) has invited the Government of Sri Lanka to submit qualified nominations for five Master's Degree Programmes to be conducted in the Republic of Korea. Enclosed for your reference are the programme details and the list of degree courses (Annexure I and II).

In line with the objectives and eligibility criteria outlined in the scholarship guidelines, the Government of Sri Lanka is requested to nominate candidates who are well-suited to benefit from and contribute to these programmes. KOICA will accept a maximum of four (04) nominations per course, underscoring the importance of careful and considered selection.

Detailed programme information, including eligibility criteria, scholarship coverage, application instructions, and guidance on university enrollment, is available on the KOICA CIAT website: http://www.koica.go.kr/ciat/index.do and External Resources Department (ERD) website: www.erd.gov.lk. Applicants are encouraged to carefully review the KOICA application guidelines before submission.

You are kindly requested to circulate this information among all Departments, Divisions, Institutes, and Provincial/District administrations under your purview, and to submit the nominations, along with the

following documents, to the Department of External Resources (ERD) by **4.00 P.M. on 24th November 2025**, in strict accordance with the provisions of the existing TA Circular.

- 1. KOICA Application Form (original and one copy with photographs)
- 2. Government Recommendation Letter (original and four copies)
- 3. Copy of the relevant pages of the passport
- Documents Checklist
- Duly completed ERD Form available on www.erd.gov.lk

As only four nominations per course can be submitted to KOICA, applications exceeding this number for any single programme will be carefully reviewed and shortlisted by a designated committee, which may include a KOICA Sri Lanka official. Final selections will subsequently be made by KOICA and the respective universities.

To prevent any administrative difficulties, nominees are advised to use their names exactly as they appear in their passports in all programme-related documentation. Kindly note that the submission deadline will be strictly observed, and only complete applications received by the stipulated deadline will be considered. KOICA does not assume responsibility for issues arising from incomplete or late submissions; applicants must ensure compliance with all requirements.

Once selections are communicated, candidates are expected to honor their acceptance and refrain from withdrawing except under exceptional and unavoidable circumstances. This training opportunity is extended for the benefit of the country, and withdrawals after selection may limit opportunities for other deserving candidates. We therefore encourage Ministries and Organizations to ensure that applications are submitted with a firm commitment to participate.

For effective representation of Sri Lanka, nominations should take into account the nominees' expertise, continuity in the relevant portfolio, and capacity to contribute meaningfully to the programme agenda. Selected candidates are required to uphold and advance Sri Lanka's national interests with the highest standards of professionalism, integrity, and consistency throughout the programme.
