

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR TACTICAL DRIVING COURSE
(FOREIGN TRAINEES)

Aim

1. Aim of the Tactical Driving Course is to train selected Gazetted Officers, Subordinate Officers (SOs) and drivers of Highly Threatened Persons (Protected Person) in order to achieve highest degree of proficiency in Defensive/ Evasive and Tactical Driving during protective motorcade operations.

Training Aspects

2. **Course Duration.** 4 weeks.

3. **Pre-Course Training.** All trainees to have undergone a minimum of two weeks pre course training and should be conversant.

4. **Work Schedule.** There will be six working days in a week and nine periods of 40 minutes duration daily.

5. **Requirement.** The trainees should fulfill these qualitative requirements (QRs) to attend this course :-

(a) **Service.** Minimum five years of active service and a residual service of minimum three years. Five years driving experience of light vehicle.

(b) **Age.** Maximum permissible age will be 40 years.

(c) **Educational Qualification.** Minimum high school graduate having basic knowledge of English/ Hindi.

(d) **Medical & Physical.** Should be medically and physically fit in all respect.

(e) **Discipline.** The trainees should be of high discipline/ character.

(f) Should be a volunteer.

6. **Screening Test.** An initial screening test will be conducted on **first day of first week** to judge the skills of each trainee.

Methodology of Training

8. **Result.** The participants who qualify in the above test protocols will be issued with the course certificate.

Administrative Aspects

9. **Documentation.** All trainees will carry the following :-

- (a) Passport.
- (b) I-Card (Authority letter by the organisation if submitted before travel).
- (c) Medical fitness certificate signed by Medical Officer.
- (d) Willingness certificate.
- (e) Movement order.
- (f) Ten passport size photographs in uniform.
- (g) Pre-Course certificate duly signed by Officer Commanding Unit.
- (h) Must have valid four wheeler driving licence.

10. **Clothing.** Details of the clothing and equipment required to be brought by each trainee is given below :-

- (a) Uniform Set - Two pairs/ winter/ summer.
(Depending on the weather).
- (b) Cape Water Proof - One (During Monsoon season).
- (c) PT Shoes - One pair.
- (d) Socks for PT - Five pair.
- (e) Boot Ankle/ DMS - One pair.
- (f) Jungle Boot - One pair.
- (g) Cap Field Service and Beret - One each.
- (h) **Private Clothing.** Each trainee should carry sufficient private clothing according to prevalent weather conditions as per para 13.

11. **Visit.** During the course, the trainees will be taken to Delhi/ Agra for the visit.

12. **Leave.** No leave will be granted during the course except on compassionate grounds and correspondence by the embassy.

13. **Weather Conditions.**
