<p>Training Content</p>	<p>The Seminar will be held online and adopt a combination of lectures, case studies, and group discussion, focusing on the topics of national and forestry conditions, ecological civilization in China, forest land management and tree logging, interpretation to regulations and legal system of natural forest management and protection, quality evaluation criteria of sustainable forest management in China, policy interpretation of prohibiting commercial logging of natural forests, combating illegal logging and related trade, interpretation of <i>Forest Law</i> and punishment of the law violation, case sharing of natural forest protection, interpretation to Medium and Long-term Plan for the Protection and Restoration of Natural Forest, progress and measures of China Natural Forest Protection Project and so on.</p> <p>The seminar will arrange the sections of country reports and discussions and the participants are advised to prepare materials in advance. In the section of country reports, the tentative outline for sharing is as follows: general introduction to the participating country such as geography, culture, society, etc.; introduction to the protection and management on forest management and natural forest protection in the participating countries.</p> <p>In the section of discussions, there are different topics. For the topic of exploring bilateral and multilateral cooperation, we will set up a discussion session between National Forestry and Grassland Administration of China (highest forestry authorities in China) and the participating countries. Participants are advised to know the current situation and challenges of natural forest protection and think about the possibility of expanding cooperation. The Seminar will also collect training needs to make the next training more targeted and effective.</p>
